In the United States, projects from the following states are eligible: Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon, Texas, Utah, Washington and Wyoming.

International projects in any and all international countries of the world are eligible.

Previous Merit Award winners are eligible for the 2010 program, if they meet eligibility criteria described.

EXCLUSIONS

Previous Grand Award winners are not eligible in the same category, unless there have been distinct design changes. Projects for which the architect or builder is a member of the 2010 panel of judges are not eligible for the 2010 Gold Nugget competition. Please review the following information carefully.
